2011 stadium fixtures have gotten off to a great start with club matches, kids activity days, the Dublin Spring Series of League matches and Allianz League Finals. We would like to thank you all for your cooperation on event days. An update on fixtures and events is detailed overleaf.

The next Community Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday 31st May. The agenda for this includes an update from the last meeting (1st Feb), an update on the Take That concerts in June and a workshop on the applications process for the Croke Park Community Fund.

Stadium contractors are committed to sourcing labour locally where possible. In their first recruitment drive for seasonal staff, Fitzers Catering appointed 16 of the 19 local people who applied for positions. They will have their next recruitment drive on 1st June and details are overleaf.

Croke Park Community Fund

Launched in mid 2009, to date the Croke Park Community Fund has supported 52 local projects. Among these are 18 schools, 10 community groups / residents associations, 4 local festivals and a mixture of after school clubs, charities and local organisations. The fund has allocated over €180,000 with a further €100,000 available to support projects in 2011.
