of the round tower of

later I took the job
of ~~the~~ teacher in
my native parish,
~~1865~~ while the permanent

me down to the middle
of 1866.

The second half of the

Year 1866 found me
on Training as a
Schoolmaster in Dublin.

Decr. 31. 1866 found me
Teacher of the Longhutra
National School. My
Class was First of
Second - the highest
possibly attainable
at the time for a man
or boy of my age and
experience.
